

Minutes from May 14, 2013 OHMHA Board Meeting

1. The meeting was called to order around 7:30 pm and the agenda was approved.
2. Minutes from the March meeting were discussed but not approved as a quorum was lacking at that point in the meeting.
3. Wendy gave a brief Treasurer's report. The Association is in a solid financial position.
4. Jack led a discussion about publicity for the Neighborhood Garage Sale. Ways to advertise the event include posting signs throughout the neighborhood, sending an email to our residents, and posting ads with Craigslist, annarbor.com, the Ann Arbor Chronicle, and the Ann Arbor Journal.
5. The board discussed again the appearance of the Burbank and Plymouth Road entrances to the neighborhood. We discussed the Georgetown plantings and their maintenance. We discussed a price quote received for removing and replacing the dying evergreen at the Burbank entrance and decided to secure a second estimate before proceeding further. The board agreed to form a subcommittee to examine the brick work at the Georgetown entrance and make a recommendation on how best to proceed. Jerry agreed to serve as one of the members.
6. The board discussed plans for the upcoming Annual General Meeting on May 31. Chris White, AATA manager of service development, is the invited speaker for the meeting.
