 - a. Interesting facts – Ann Arbor has approximately:
 - i. 283 miles of asphalt roads (95 “Major” and 188 “Local”)
 - ii. 12 miles of gravel roads
 - iii. 4.5 miles of concrete roads
 - iv. Just less than 1 mile of brick road
 - b. Prioritization is guided by Pavement Asset Management principles (find more info on the [Street Construction Selection](#) section of our website)
 - c. Projects or Programs are programmed in the City’s 5-year [Capital Improvements Plan](#)
 - d. Local Streets are programmed as part of the Annual Street Resurfacing Program (full street list can be found at the [Construction Projects](#) section of our website)

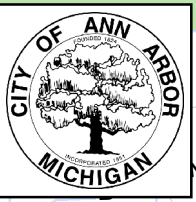
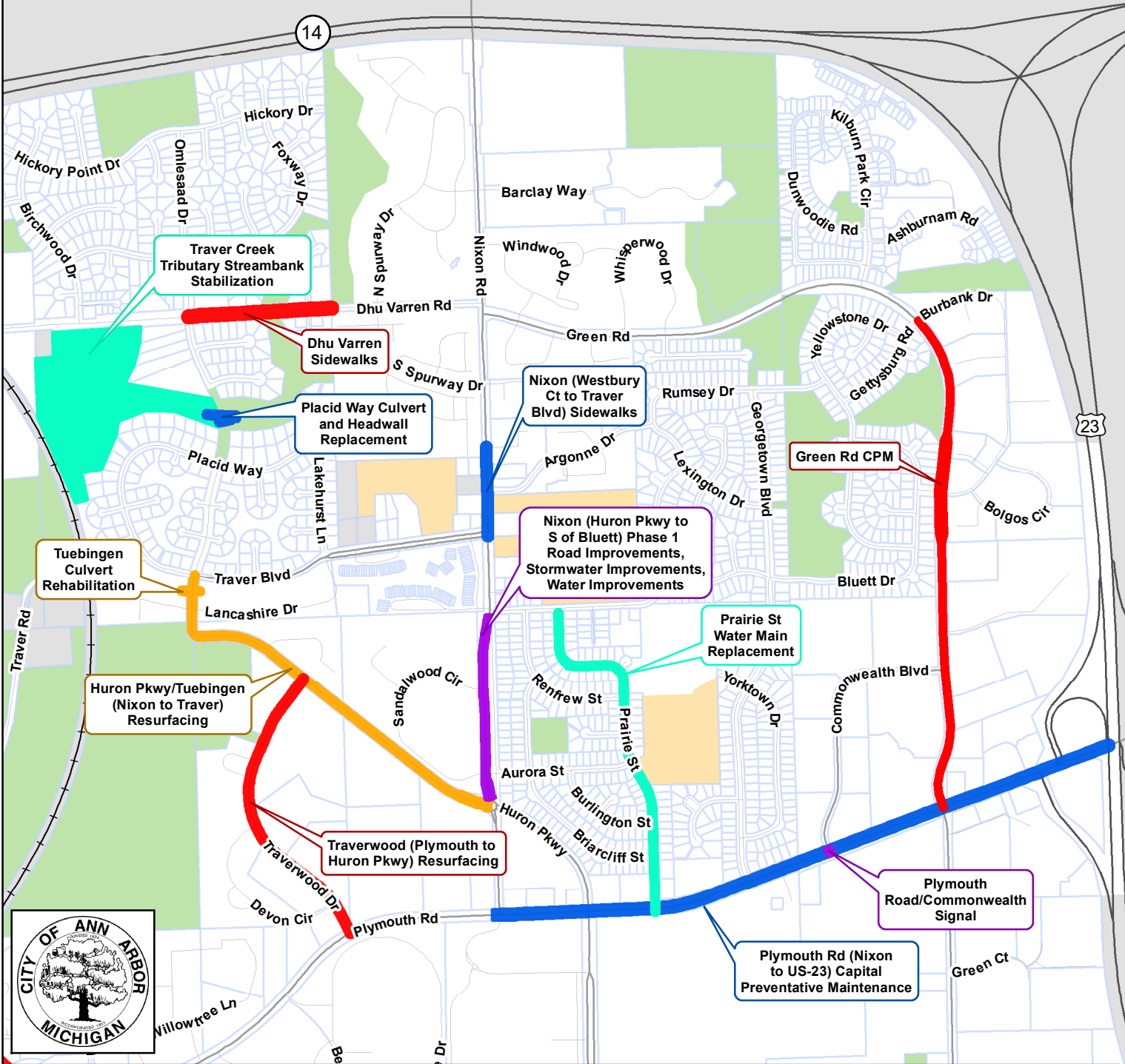
